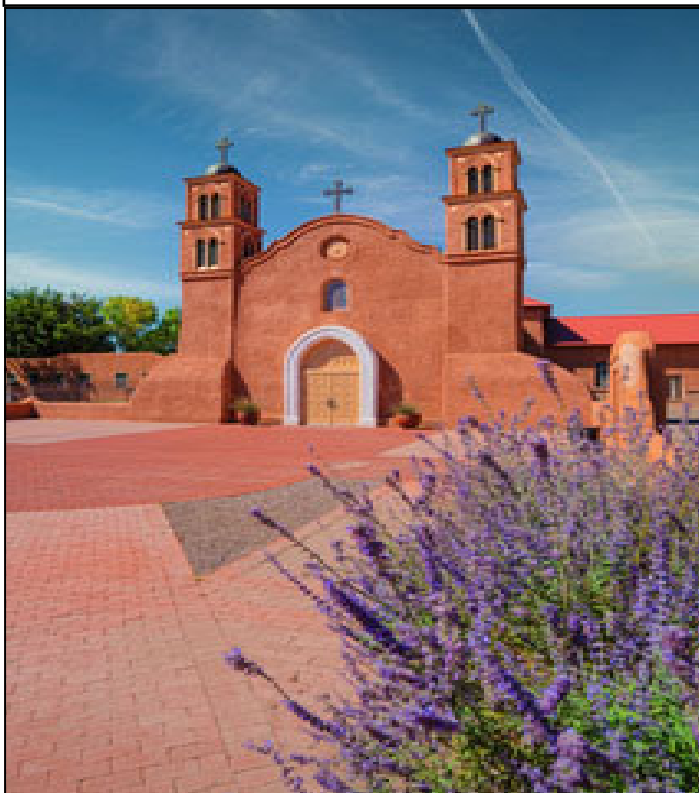

Parish Vision Statement

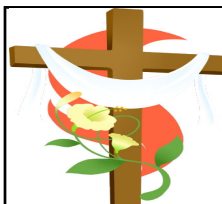
