**May Crowning of Mary**

Please join the Religious Education students for a beautiful Crowning of Our Blessed Mother, followed by a rosary and a procession by our First Holy Communicants, tomorrow/today May 3rd, following the 10am Mass at the Pavilion behind the church.



**The Tradition of Crowning Mary**

The May Crowning of Mary is a beloved tradition in which a statue or image of the Blessed Virgin Mary is ceremonially crowned with a wreath of flowers. It honors her as Queen of Heaven and Queen of May, and entrusts our lives and the world’s needs to her maternal intercession.

The custom grew in the West after the Council of Ephesus (A.D. 431), which declared Mary Theotokos (Mother of God). By the 19th century, public May crownings had become widespread. Pope Pius XII’s 1954 encyclical *Ad Caeli Reginam* strengthened the practice by proclaiming Mary’s Queenship.

The queen of a Davidic kingdom was not one of the king’s wives but is the mother of the king (see 1 Kings 2:19). Of Jesus, the Angel tells Mary, “He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give him the throne of David his father, and he will rule over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end” (Luke 1:32-33). Theologically, the crowning expresses Mary’s royal dignity as Mother of the Heavenly King and therefore Queen of Heaven. Revelation 12:1 presents her as the “woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars”.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that devotion to Mary is intrinsic to Christian worship and that the Church rightly honors the Blessed Virgin with special devotion. (CCC 971). It is important to note however, that even though she is given an honor greater than the saints she is not worshipped like God, who is adored above all things.


The simple acts of singing Marian hymns and placing the crown draw the faithful closer to Jesus through His Mother, whose “yes” reversed Eve’s “no” and became the fulfilment of God’s warning to the serpent in Genesis 3:15, “I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; They will strike at your head, while you strike at their heel.”



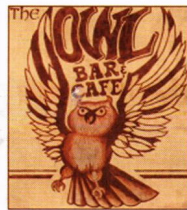
