## SACRAMENTS

To receive Sacraments at San Miguel Church, you must be registered and active at the Parish. If you are unsure if you are registered, please contact the Parish Office to verify.

**Baptism:** Pre-baptism instruction is required for parents and god-parents. Sponsors/godparents must be practicing Catholics in good standing with the Church, at least 16 years of age, have received all their Sacraments of Initiation and if married, must be married in the Catholic Church. If the godparent is single, they must not be co-habiting. Parents and godparents must attend baptismal classes before the baptism of the child. **The next class is June 4, 2026 at 6:30PM.** Parents must register their child at least two weeks before attending class. Contact the office for additional information.

**First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion:** This is a program that usually begins in the 2nd grade and lasts a minimum of two years. Contact the Religious Education director for additional information.

**Confirmation:** This is a program that usually begins in the 8th grade and lasts a minimum of two years. Those teens who are registering for Confirmation classes must be Baptized and have received their 1st Holy Communion. Contact the Religious Education director at the Parish Office for additional information.

**Marriage:** Couples who plan to marry at San Miguel Church must contact the Parish Office at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. A mandatory pre-marriage program is required.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Please contact the Parish Office.

**Funeral Mass:** The cost for funeral services is \$150. Please contact the office for additional information and to coordinate services as soon as possible.

**Memorial Day**

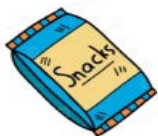

**A New OCIA Cycle Begins June 1**

Is someone you know interested in becoming Catholic or learning more about the Catholic Church?

The **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA)** is the process by which adults come to know the Catholic faith and prepare to enter fully into the life of the Church. It is also a place for anyone with questions about Catholicism, as well as for baptized Catholics who still need to receive sacraments such as **First Holy Communion** or **Confirmation**.

A new OCIA cycle will begin on **Monday, June 1**, and sessions will be held each Monday at **6:30 PM** in the **Church Office Conference Room**.

If you know someone who is not Catholic but is interested in the Church, someone who has been away and would like to return, or a Catholic who is ready to take the next step, this is the time to come. All are welcome. If you have any questions, please contact the church office.
