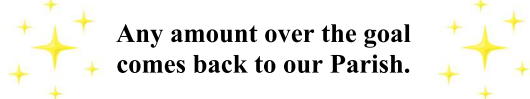

SACRAMENTS

***To receive Sacraments at San Miguel Church, you must be registered
and active at the Parish. If you are unsure if you are registered, please
contact the Parish Office to verify.***

Baptism: Pre-baptism instruction is required for parents and godparents. Sponsors/godparents must be practicing Catholics in good standing with the Church, at least 16 years of age, have received all their Sacraments of Initiation and if married, must be married in the Catholic Church. If the godparent is single, they must not be cohabiting. Parents and godparents must attend baptismal classes before the baptism of the child. **The next class is September 3, 2026 at 6:30PM.** Parents must register their child at least two weeks before attending class. Contact the office for additional information.

First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion: This is a program that usually begins in the 2nd grade and lasts a minimum of two years. Contact the Religious Education director for additional information.

Confirmation: This is a program that usually begins in the 8th grade and lasts a minimum of two years. Those teens who are registering for Confirmation classes must be Baptized and have received their 1st Holy Communion. Contact the Religious Education director at the Parish Office for additional information.

Marriage: Couples who plan to marry at San Miguel Church must contact the Parish Office at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. A mandatory pre-marriage program is required.

Anointing of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office.

Funeral Mass: The cost for funeral services is \$150. Please contact the office for additional information and to coordinate services as soon as possible.

TUESDAY BIBLE STUDY

Tuesday Bible Study returns this fall, and our topic will be Handel's Messiah and the Messianic prophecies of Scripture.



Most of us recognize the music of Handel's Messiah. But we are less familiar with the prophets and the prophecies that form much of the biblical story behind the music.

In class we will use Handel's Messiah as a doorway into the Messianic prophecies of the Old Testament, discovering how the words of the prophets arose from real events in the history of Israel while also creating an expectation of God's future work.

Messiah musically follows the biblical story from Messianic promise to Christ's Resurrection to his eternal reign, and our hope of resurrection and everlasting life.

We will also learn about George Frideric Handel, Charles Jennens, the nature of biblical prophecy, and the remarkable way Scripture, theology, and music come together in one of the greatest works of the Christian musical tradition.
